

the highest award in India given to children up to the age of 17. Currently, he even holds a patent for this invention.



Initially, the host of the episode Mr Aniket Arora asked a few questions to Mr Parth regarding his journey and later on started taking questions from the audience. Throughout the episode, the audience kept their engagement at a high level and kept feeding their curiosity. They asked several questions related to his patent and his role model. his ideology, his favourite moments, his success and failure during the project, and his family's support throughout the project.
