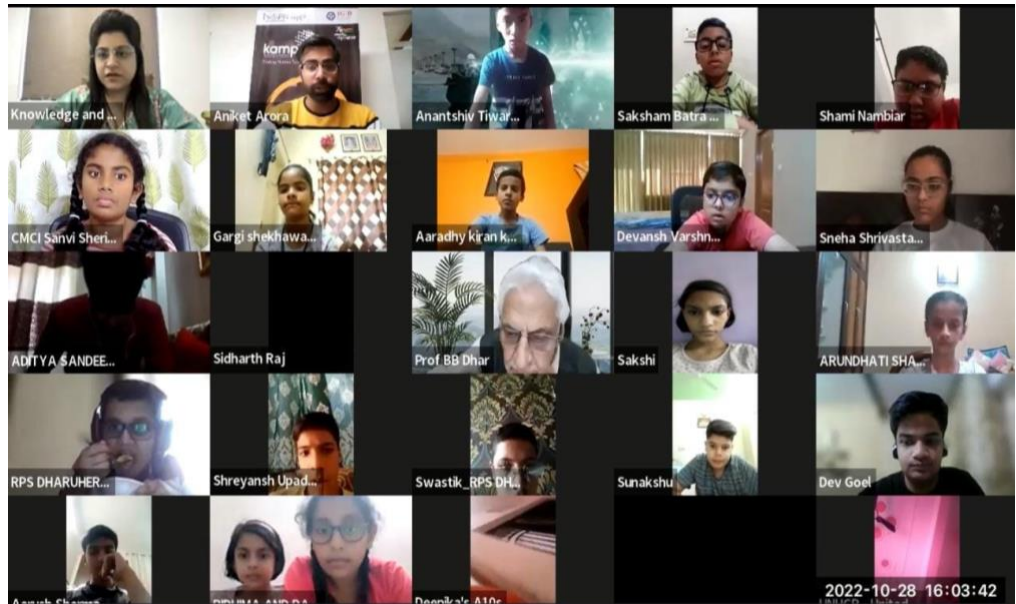

The main objective of KAMP is to map the science process skills and scientific attitudes of young students based on their assessment and nurture them as future scientists in the country. KAMP believes that every student is blessed with a core talent and seeks to bring out the best in them through this platform. With this, they aim to inculcate

critical thinking ability within them and fill in the gaps that prevent them from achieving their highest potential.

"Achievers: The Leaders of Tomorrow" is a series that aims to inspire students to be creative, discover their true potential, be inspired by great things in life, and help develop the nation through their unique ideas. For this episode, KAMP invited a young achiever, Mr Onkar Singh Batra, who has received the Pradhanmantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar 2020 for being the Youngest Theoretical Author as well as the Youngest Web Developer. He created his first website when he was seven years old, and by the time he was twelve, he had published his first theoretical book, "When the Time Stops.". Currently, at the age of 16, he is the Founder and CEO of Paradox Sonic Space Research (PSSR) International Agency, where he is developing a satellite.

With 1478 participants, this episode of the "Achievers-The Leaders of Tomorrow" was graced by the presence of Prof. B. B. Dhar (Chairman of KAMP Planning and Monitoring committee), Mr. Ashish Mittal, Member-KAMP Planning and Monitoring Committee, and Ms. Arika Mathur, Member-KAMP Planning and Monitoring Committee.



Prof B. B. Dhar was very much impressed with the clarity Onkar had concerning what he is doing at such a small age, and the commendable wisdom he shared with the even younger audience. He actively guided students on how to be better observers, avoid distractions, and manage tasks at hand, among many other general things he learned through his experience in aerospace and aeronautics.
